## Accommodations for Applicants with Disabilities

The University of Tokyo provides reasonable accommodations to ensure that individuals with disabilities are not disadvantaged during entrance examinations and studies after enrollment, and provides consultation services for this purpose.

Those who wish to request accommodations for entrance examination are required to contact the Gakumu Team (Academic Affairs Division) by the following deadline. Based on the requested accommodations, the applicants will be notified of the necessary application documents. After reviewing each request, the University will determine the accommodations appropriate to the type and degree of the disability and will inform the applicant of the result.

\* Although requests made after the above deadline will still be considered, it is recommended that applicants send their requests well in advance as it may not be possible to provide certain accommodations without sufficient preparation time.

In cases where hearing aids, canes, wheelchairs or other aids used in daily life are employed during the exam, it is also necessary for applicants to request accommodations due to preparation of the exam venue.
